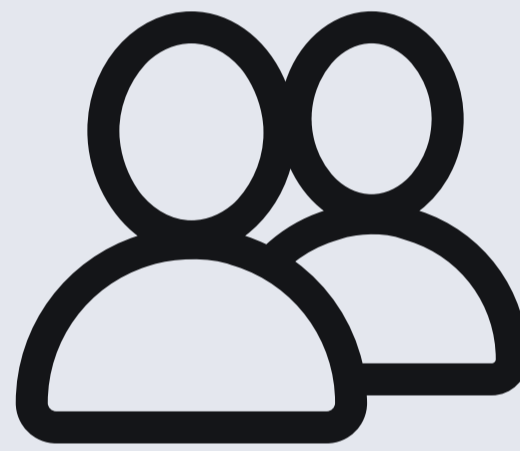
General Services

Permanent Supportive Housing

- **Lifeways:** Ten 811 units; tenant selection and case management (voucher admin. assistance from NWRECC)
- **OHOP (OHA):** 3 units with client support, case management, TBV's
- **CinA:** 3 units homeless set-aside, tenant selection & case management

✓ Agency

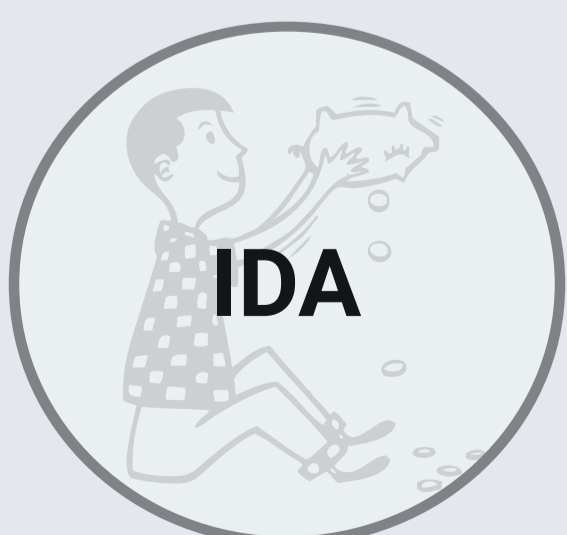
Foster ownership and self-sufficiency among residents for involvement in their individual service plans; and care of their homes, the property, and each other
